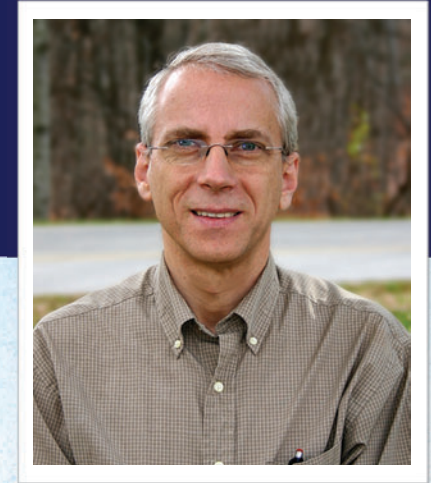

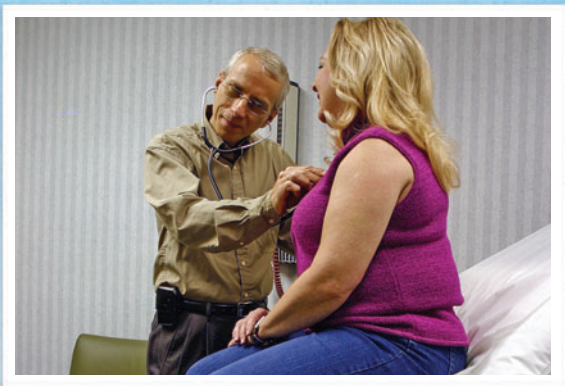

What is an Internal Medicine physician?
